Additional qualifications and abilities include: understanding the complexities of managing a Division I Athletic Program noted for its very high graduation rate, gender-equity compliance, and conference competitiveness; providing leadership, guidance and strategic planning to multiple directors and departments; serving as an active and positive member of the Senior Management team that supports the President of the College; a commitment to professional development as evidenced by membership and leadership in professional organizations. Candidates must demonstrate a commitment to diversity and possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills. A minimum of 10-15 years professional experience in a college/university setting, including extensive experience with student affairs administration, policies, and services, is essential.
