The Johnston Institute focuses on deepening participants' understanding of De La Salle's story and vision, Lasallian pedagogy, the Lasallian promotion of justice and Lasallian spirituality while utilizing contemporary texts to inform and influence current and future Lasallian practice. This formation program is designed for Lasallians (Brothers and Partners) who exercise mission influence and/or show potential for such in the future. Participants will engage in prayer, study, reflection and dialogue that will provide opportunities for assisting in more deeply animating our shared mission on the local level and within the broader Lasallian family.

Course of Studies: The Johnston Institute, a two-year formation program, meets in District and Regional sessions during the summer, fall and spring. Three online sessions (December 2019, April 2020 and September 2020) provide opportunities for continued reflection and discussion between in-person sessions.
